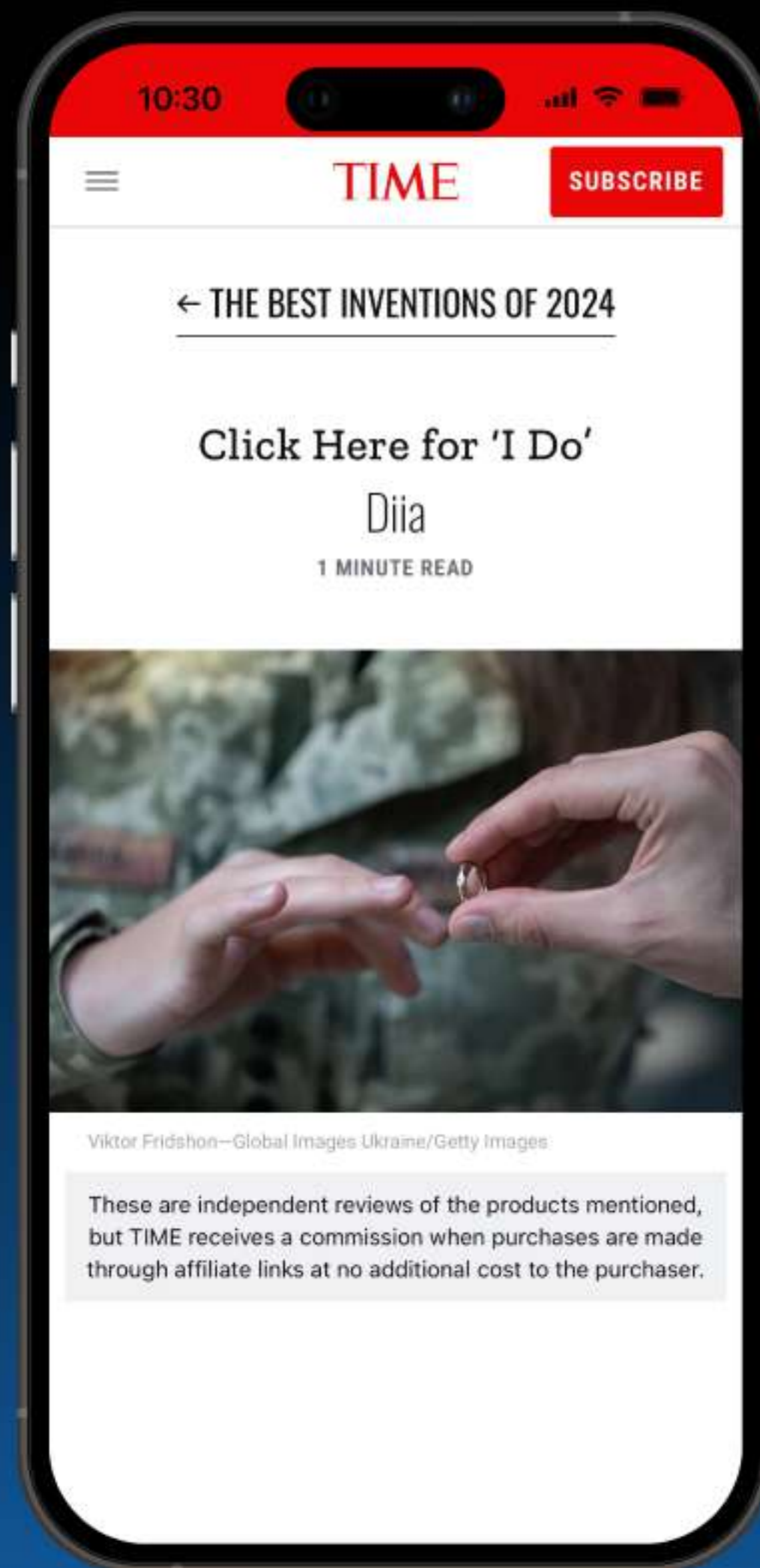

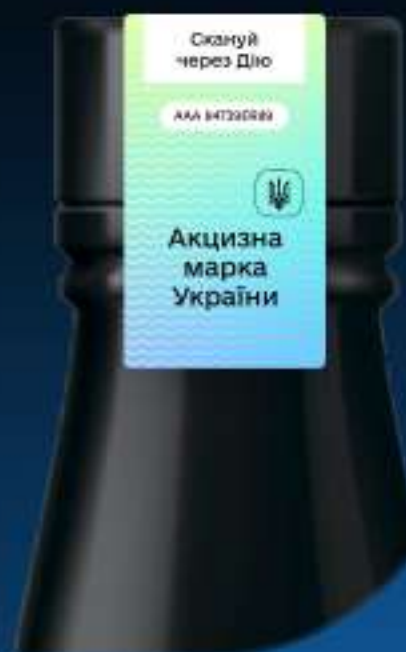

A strategic partnership encompassing digital public services, education, and innovation

2023

- Cooperation in the field of digital education was expanded
- A memorandum was signed with the UK's Department for Business and Trade
- The UK-Ukraine Tech Bridge was launched between the UK government and the MinDigit to strengthen ties between the two countries' technological ecosystems

Through the program, thousands of Ukrainians received training from leading international companies such as Deloitte, Oracle, Salesforce, Cisco, and Re:coded

Access to expert support from InnovateUK, techUK, and Edenbase

The UK-Ukraine Tech Bridge facilitated the participation of a national delegation at London Tech Week and organised key events such as the UK-Ukraine Tech Forum, Cybersecurity Roundtable, and Tech Unity: UK & Ukraine

The launch of the Investment Accelerator, where 20 startups raised \$7.4 million in investments and grants within six months

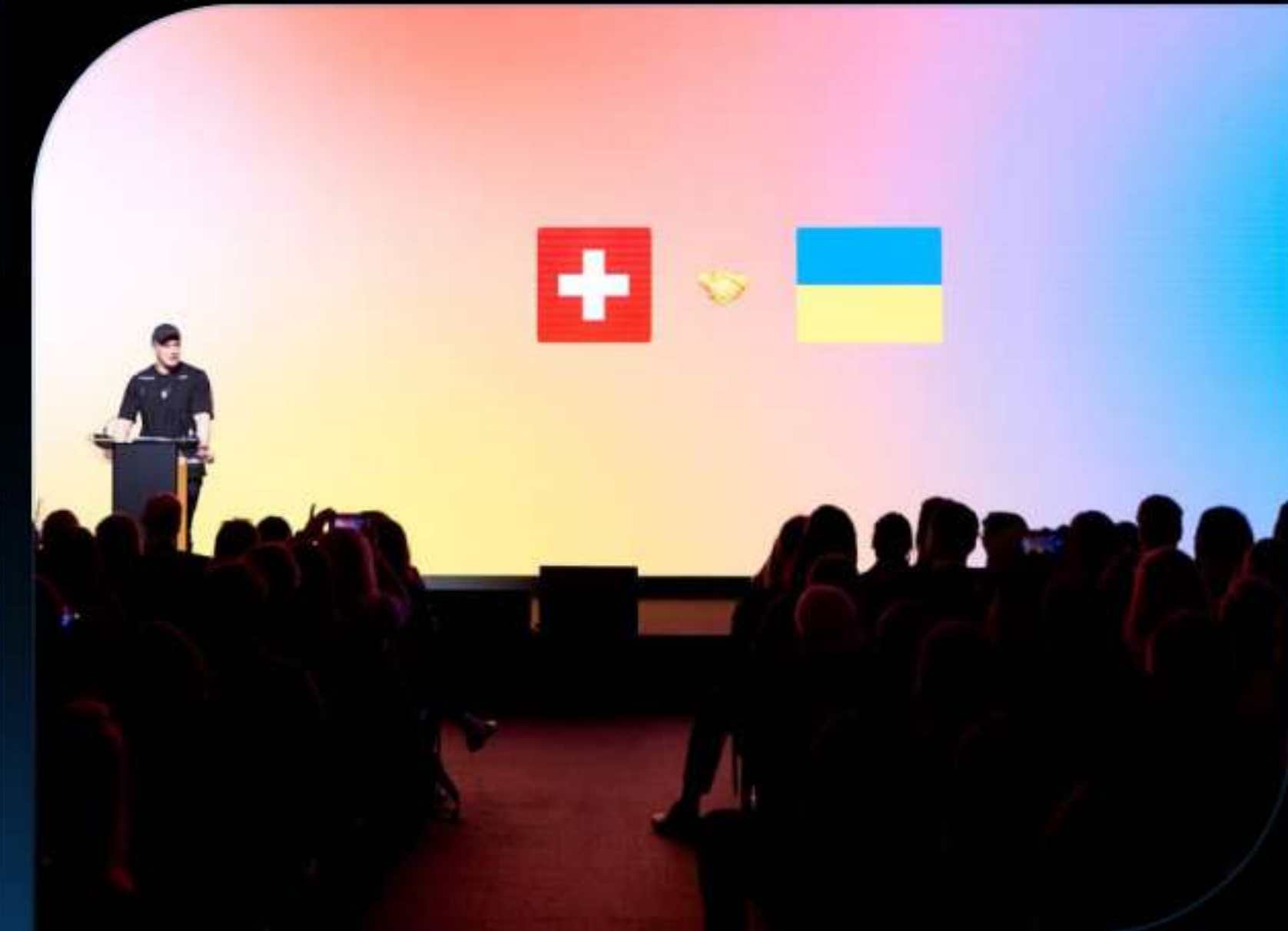

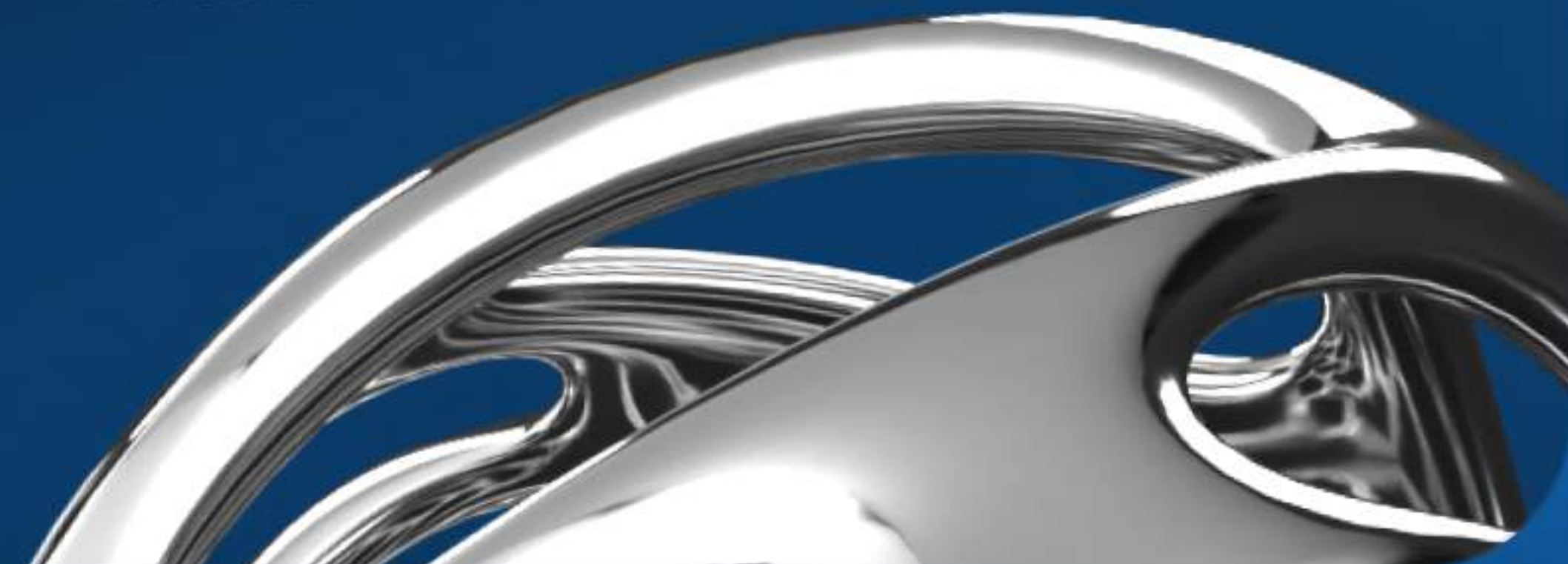

Ukraine – Quebec

Implementation of innovative solutions to improve the accessibility and quality of public services

By leveraging Quebec's experience, Ukraine is enhancing governmental transparency and modernising digital platforms

Ukraine – Latvia

2023

A Memorandum of Cooperation was signed

This partnership aims to exchange expertise in spectrum policy, telecommunications, and accessing European funding

Latvia provides technical assistance by preparing recommendations for telecom development and guides for securing EU funding

Ukraine – Germany

The partnership between Ukraine and Germany, implemented through the German organisation GIZ, plays a significant role in Ukraine's digital transformation

GIZ actively supports expanding Diia's functionality, introducing new services, and enhancing user experience

Special emphasis is placed on educational initiatives such as Diia.Education, which focuses on boosting digital skills among citizens, entrepreneurs, and public servants

GIZ facilitates the development of digital leaders through the CDTO Campus initiative and supports pilot GovTech projects

Ukraine – Austria

The partnership between Ukraine and Austria focuses on digitalisation and the restoration of broadband internet infrastructure

Ukraine – Japan

2023

The Ministry of Digital Transformation of Ukraine signed a memorandum with the Ministry of Digitalisation of Japan

The cooperation focuses on ensuring maximum protection of Ukraine's critical infrastructure, leveraging Japan's unique expertise in countering cyberattacks

2024

A joint CTF competition was held to enhance the protection of digital infrastructure

Japan, through its partnership with Rakuten, supports the implementation of telecommunications solutions, telemedicine, and educational projects, contributing to the integration of Diia
